Club 18th Birthday - Bob asked Charter Members to share some stories:

Joe Anelle --

- 1st meeting was held February 3, 2000. At that time there were 16 members in attendance. A number of the people had been involved with another Corvette Club that just wasn't much fun anymore. Jeff Anderson provided the selected name for the club and Joe Anelle designed the original Club Logo and Club Banner. 52 members joined Route 66 the first year.
- Tim Adams was the 1st President
- Joe, Scott and Noel all spoke about the First Car Show. It was 2002 and was held at Vettes Restaurant in St. Charles. Tom Reitz took a first place and Joe took a 2nd place (Joe showed his trophy). The first show had about 80 cars and the following year 90+ and probably had about 60 members at the time. One year had 129 cars with 85 that had registered. Noel said they had enough cars that they had to park them three abreast and had to be last in first out in order to move. In about 2008/09 Car Show moved to Jim Trenary Chevrolet - the Club sponsor at the time. The first year at Trenary had 80+ cars. When we had Robert as our new sponsor, the Car Show moved to Bowling Green, MO.

Tom Reitz --

- 1st Autocross was in October 2000 and held at the GM plant in Wentzville. Didn't have any equipment so had to borrow money from club members to buy needed equipment like cones, flags and other items. The Autocross did well, and the Club was able to pay back the members after the event. We have had the Autocross every year since 2000 and still use the same cones today. GM eventually planned an expansion and we had to look for another location for Autocross. Around 2014 we moved Autocross to the Family Arena in St. Charles.
- The first Governor was Gary Hellyer. Gary joked with Tom that the only way to get out of being Governor is to quit the club.

Noel Wilson --

Noel had retired and a friend, Jackie Miget, had suggested he go to a Corvette meeting (the old, original club). After a couple of meetings, they felt it did not meet their expectation, so they ended up joining when the Route 66 Club was being created. Back then there were a lot of spur-of-the-moment types of things they would get together and do. Everyone got involved.

Scott Walker --

- The old club had a some personalities that did not mesh well. When Route 66 was created, to prevent what the old club experienced, originally you had to be recommended by a member to join and then you were on 1-year probation. After 1 year, a secret ballot was held for permanent membership. This practice lasted about 4 years.

- Bowling Green – There is currently no news when the plant will start up again. They are working on 2019 and probably focusing on ZR1.
- Museum – The National Corvette Museum has instituted a “love the Museum” promotion for family membership for \$50 in February. Good until February 28. Go to the Museum website, <http://www.corvettemuseum.org/> or to the museum store to sign up. The museum has recently received a C4 with 775K miles on it that will be on display.
- Attention Sharpshooters. March 4th is the date (2-5 p.m.) to go to Sharpshooters on Gravois. A signup sheet is being passed around. \$40 per person which includes BBQ buffet and 3 hours of range time. We will probably have 6-10 lanes available to us. NRA instructors will be there to assist. They do let you bring your own guns/rifle. No Steel Bullets. If you don't have your own gun, they have guns available to use. They do have eye and ear protectors available. The facility is air-conditioned & heated. Eating and ranges in close proximity. About 20 people have signed up so far. We will probably go to Ted Drewes afterward. Have to be 18 to be able to shoot.

AUTOCROSS

I am working on 2018 now and have a hold for September 15-16, 2018 with the arena. This is the week BEFORE Funfest. The budget for autocross was presented and passed in January, (see minutes for details) and will include:

- 14 events at the Family Arena
- Indoor restroom facility use
- Timing services
- Sanction purchases from St. Louis Corvette Club
- T-shirts for participants and workers

Expenses total \$3,900 with an estimated income of \$5,640 from entry fees based on 46 entries. We had 59 last year. This budget does not include any food purchases or sales as that is a separate committee, which should net approximately \$300 or more.


