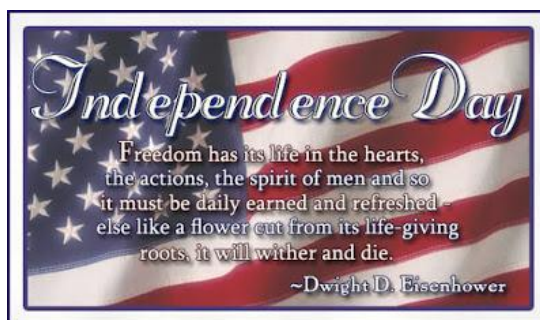

Gateway Vehicle Inspection Program - Mileage Based Exemption: Noel Wilson

- Emission inspections exemption available for low mileage cars
 - Applies to vehicles registered in the counties of Franklin, Jefferson, St. Charles, St. Louis and the City of St. Louis
 - Less than 12,000 miles in 2 years or less than 40,000 miles on a new car in 1st 2 years
- When you receive your license renewal, call the Missouri Department of Natural Resources at 800-361-4827 or 314-416-2115 or there is a fillable PDF available at <https://dnr.mo.gov/forms/780-1972-f.pdf>
- Details on requirements available on the above form
- Typically fast approval; entered into computer system also accessible through the DMV
- Can do it for the life of the vehicle, but must do every 2 years
