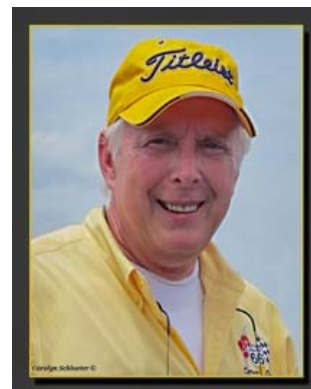

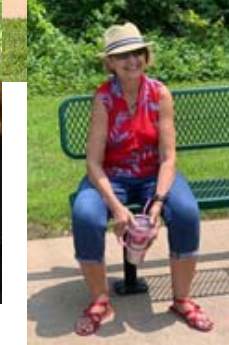

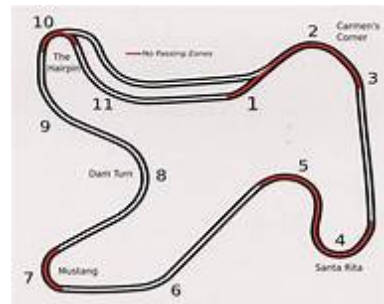

AUTOCROSS

Autocross runs rain or shine. We do have indoor restrooms with A/C, and we will plan a location for dinner on Saturday evening for entrants and workers. All workers will receive an event T-shirt.

Workers typically need to be at the arena by 7:45am and we intend to be fully completed by 4:00pm on Saturday and 3:00pm on Sunday. If you work, you may leave at any time (please notify someone if you are leaving). Part day working is 100% O.K.

All workers, entrants, and spectators MUST sign the waiver form. We have a specific waiver form for minors (under 18 years old) which must also be signed by ONE parent or legal guardian. Waivers will be either at Registration table or the food tent.

Please bring a two-way FRS radio(s) if you intend to work. We will use channel 6 (no sub-channel) for on course and staging activities. The club has about a dozen loaner radios if you do not have one.

This is an important event for our club as it raises money that is used for club operations and is not earmarked for any charitable donation.

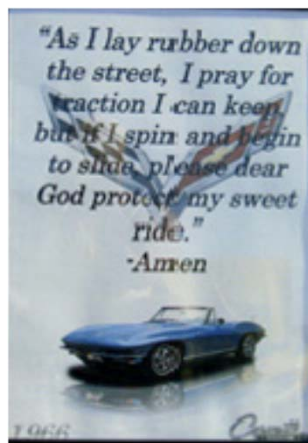
