NCCC Governor's Report: (cont.)

Craig presented charts at the March meeting supporting a discussion to discontinue club membership in NCCC. Here is a link to those slides: A Look Into NCCC

Key Points:

- We pay dues for about 210 members at a cost of \$5000 for the Club.
- We have about 10 members that attend competitive NCCC events, about \$24 per member.
- NCCC provides liability insurance for the club and Directors and Officers in that cost.
- We can get liability insurance and D&O insurance for about \$1300 per year independent of NCCC.
- Members that compete can join another club that is an NCCC member to continue to compete.

We will discuss this topic again next month. We must decide about it before starting membership renewals in October.

Further discussion related to NCCC – the floor is open for comments.

- Tom Reitz 25-year NCCC governor spoke. The Club was formed in 2000 as a NCCC club. He noted that the Club documents would need to be revised as they specifically state that the Club will be an NCCC member. He is worried that private insurance will be difficult to renew if there is a claim. What is the intention for membership fees if we no longer charge for NCCC membership?
- Dennis Osterhorn asked about how the insurance works.
- Tom offered that insurance pays for damages that occur as part of a club event. D&O coverage covers the board for club activities. Personal insurance covers damage to cars.
- Paul Kaus suggested keeping dues as is, not to join NCCC for 2026, get Hagerty insurance and have a couple \$\$ for a charity fund or Christmas fund.
- Paul noted that quotes from Hagerty showed that insurance comparable to what NCCC provides would cost about \$1200 for the Club. We currently spend about \$5000 for NCCC membership which includes their insurance.
