These revised documents will go into effect January 2026 as a requirement since we are leaving the NCCC. Greg Fultz motioned to accept the changes made for NCCC removal. Dennis Osterhorn seconded.

Paul Kaus noted that the club will now be paying directly for liability and D&O insurance. NCCC dues had supplied that insurance. We had been sending \$5K to the NCCC. Insurance will cost about \$2K for us outside of NCCC leaving more \$\$\$ available for donation to charities.

There was no other discussion needed.

We voted tonight for approval of the changes tonight. All present voted in favor of the revised club documents.
