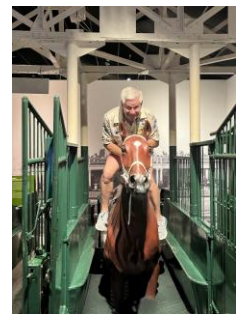
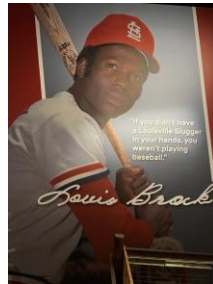

The car currently has 57,000 miles on the odometer. The car is named "The Queen" by my family. She lives on a throne in my garage! (A car lift). I drive her about 500 miles per year. She has quite the life!

The car does quite well at car shows. She has won over 25 awards and one Best of Show trophy.
