NCCC Report / Update:

Craig Fultz made a motion to separate from NCCC. And to leave the club dues and fees as they are until next year. Bob Lamb seconded the motions. A discussion was held prior to voting.

Pros and Cons were put on each table and are copied below:

Pros:

- Founded in 1959
- Over 16,000 members
- Representing 250 Corvette Clubs in 16 Regions
- Blues Bars magazine is published 4 times a year
- NCCC is projecting a major deficit this year
- Children and grandchildren of NCCC members eligible for college scholarships
- Ability to attend and participate in NCCC events and Convention

Cons:

- NCCC dues of \$45 per couple \$35 per individual, has been proposed to increase in 2026 to \$65 per couple, \$50 per individual
- Participation in NCCC events is low, less than 1% of our members participate in any NCCC event
- Premier events are High and Low Speed Racing events. Most events
 in our region are in Wisconsin, Western Illinois and Northern Illinois (some in
 Minnesota).
- Route 66 holds one NCCC sanctioned event per year, our road rallye/poker run.

A few members reminded us about the vendor discounts, and non-competition events that are benefits. One stated that hotel discounts pay for his NCCC dues.

A silent / written vote was held on paper. Ballots were collected by Larry Boyd and Ian Turner. Bob Lamb will count to see that there are 61 ballots. Nancy Streib will also lend a hand.

Results: To leave NCCC: 4X . To stay in NCCC: X. The Club voted overwhelmingly to leave NCCC.

Greg made a motion to ask the board to direct the standards committee to make recommendations for changes at the next meeting. Bill Pollihan seconded. The motion passed.

Club documents will be reviewed to present the suggested revisions at the July meeting. With a second reading at the August meeting and a vote then for those changes.
