






Route 66 at the Smithsonian Museum

The Smithsonian's National Museum of American History features a permanent exhibit with a section of Route 66 pavement from 1932, originally donated by Oklahoma, that visitors can walk on. This display is part of the "America on the Move" exhibition, which also includes a restored 1930s car and truck, a "Hamons Court" neon sign from a gas station, and other Route 66 memorabilia like postcards, reflecting the highway's importance in popular culture and as a route for migration and travel.
